1. Open to all Filipino citizens.
2. All works must be strictly independent works and not produced for commercial screening. School-based works (e.g. theses) are eligible.
3. An entry must not exceed 60 minutes.
4. Entries should be presented depicting the theme "Philippine Navy: A Vital Partner for Peace, Security and Development of our Maritime Nation."
5. Cash prizes are as follows:
 - 1st PRIZE - P40,000.00
 - 2nd PRIZE - P25,000.00
 - 3rd PRIZE - P15,000.00
6. Entries must be submitted not later than 5:00pm, October 14, 2011 (Friday) at the Office of the Assistant Chief of Naval Staff for Civil Military Operations, N7 (Attn: Public Affairs Branch), Headquarters Philippine Navy, Naval Station Jose Andrada, 2335 Pres. M. Roxas Boulevard, Manila.
7. Winners shall be announced on December 17, 2011. Winners will also be informed by phone, mail, email or telegram after the competition.

CONTEST MECHANICS AND RULES

1. Open to all Filipino citizens (this includes Philippine Navy personnel and their dependents). Only entries by Filipino filmmakers will be accepted to the Short Feature Category.
2. Entries will be in digital video format (i.e. digital editing post work). The following copies will be submitted for screening and archival purposes:
 - 6 DVDs with English subtitles
 - 2 Mini-DVs with English subtitles
 - 1 Data file with English subtitles for HD playback
3. All works must be strictly independent works and not produced for commercial screening. School-based works (e.g. theses) are eligible.
4. Due to copyright laws, music used in any entry must be original. Licensed or in the public domain.
5. Entries should be presented depicting the theme "Philippine Navy: A Vital Partner for Peace, Security and Development of our Maritime Nation".
6. Dialogue should be primarily in Filipino or any Philippine language as appropriate, with English subtitles.
7. Entries must have been produced within the period of May 24, 2011 to October 14, 2011.
8. An entry must not exceed 60 minutes.
9. Each participant is allowed to submit only one (1) entry.
10. Entries must include the following:
 - A duly accomplished entry form or a facsimile, downloadable from www.navy.mil.ph. For facsimiles, please include the following:

 14. Synopsis of entry (1 to 3 paragraphs only)
 - b. Contact Details:
 - Complete Address of Filmmaker or Group Representative (see contest Rule #12)
 - Telephone and/or Fax
 - c. Conformances/Authorizations:
 - Conforme 1 (signed by person submitting entry): "This is to certify that the above mentioned entry to the competition was produced after (date of production)."
 - Conforme 2 (signed by the owner of film rights): "I hereby grant permission for the above-mentioned work to be entered in the Philippine Navy Independent Film Competition. I hereby declare all the above information true and correct. I have carefully read the rules and regulations of the competition and agree to abide by and be bound by them."
 - Authorization (signed by the owner of film rights): "I authorize the dubbing of my entry solely for the competition's promotional and archival use and for other purposes as stated in the contest rules."
 - e. Photo stills, to be submitted on separate VCD, as a JPEG file (minimum 150 resolution):
 - Two (2) 5"x7" production stills (shots from the film itself)
 - Two (2) 5"x7" production stills (behind the scenes).
11. Forms may be obtained online (see 10) or from the Public Affairs Branch (Office of the Assistant Chief of Naval Staff for Civil Military Operations, N7, Headquarters Philippine Navy, Naval Station Jose Andrada, Pres. M. Roxas Boulevard, Manila) during office hours (8:00am to 5:00pm), Monday to Friday. Regional Entries should download the forms via the internet.
12. Awards for winning entries shall be given to the filmmaker/director indicated in the entry form.
 - For joint directorial works, the group must assign a single representative to act in its behalf. All official communications shall be addressed to this representative. The Philippine Navy (PN) shall not be liable for any controversy regarding the sharing of awards among the members of the group.
13. The decision of the Board of Judges is final. The board reserves the right not to give awards should no entry merit it. In the case of ambivalence, the jurors shall decide the category of the entry.
14. Cash prizes are as follows:
 - 1st PRIZE - P40,000.00
 - 2nd PRIZE - P25,000.00
 - 3rd PRIZE - P15,000.00
15. Entries must be submitted not later than 5:00pm, October 14, 2011 (Friday) at the Office of the Assistant Chief of Naval Staff for Civil Military Operations, N7 (Attn: Public Affairs Branch), Headquarters Philippine Navy, Naval Station Jose Andrada, 2335 Pres. M. Roxas Boulevard, Manila:
 - a. The final work in DVD format, labelled with the title, production company address and contact numbers, production date, director's name and running time.
 - b. A duly completed application form.
 - c. Synopsis in Filipino or English.
 - d. A brief resume/biodata and two (2) recent 2x2 photos of the filmmakers. *All entries must be submitted in a long brown envelop properly labelled with proponent's name, title and contact details.*
16. Entries selected as finalists cannot be withdrawn from the competition.
17. Winners shall be announced on December 17, 2011. Winners will also be informed by phone, mail, email or telegram after the competition.
18. The PN reserves the right to exhibit the entries, winning or not. Also, the PN reserves the right not to screen entries it deems unsuitable for public screening.
19. The PN will ensure the safety of the films throughout the period in which the cinematographic materials are in custody. In case of loss or damaged to the materials, the PN's obligation is limited to compensating the production group only for the cost of replacing the damaged Mini DV and DVD.
20. All Mini DV and DVD shipments to the PN must be prepaid and properly labelled. The PN cannot accept any collect shipments of any entry.
21. Winning entries will be archived (copied to disc) by the PN for library purposes, as well as for possible inclusion in PN programs and productions. Films shown will be properly compensated based on existing copyright laws.
22. Entries may be picked up a week after the declaration of winners.
23. Since the competition is in tie up with the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), previous winning titles (i.e. as Best Short Film or Special Jury Prize) in the short film category of the CCP's Cinemalaya Philippine Independent Film Festival and the Gawad CCP Para sa Alternatibong Pelikula at Video are not eligible to join the competition.
